

# FROM THE CHAIRMAN

I loved what I saw and experienced in 2016 volunteering and leading the Little Rock Regional Chamber. As I spent more time away from the bubble of my own business, I became acutely aware of how thousands of energetic people interact daily throughout this region to fuel a vibrant economy and achieve amazing results. From Conway to Cabot to the core of downtown Little Rock, I saw relationships built, transactions completed, and victories celebrated as we all fulfilled our unique roles in the fascinating organism known as the Little Rock regional economy. I'm thankful to live and work here, where individuals and organizations have an attitude of cooperation and a tendency to say "yes" whenever possible.

I saw an established and successful business say yes to youthful entrepreneurship when global leaders FIS provided a major commitment of money, time, people, expertise, and guidance to The Venture Center, forming the exciting VC FinTech Accelerator. The Demo Day in August was an energizing display of bright ideas and carefully-crafted business plans attracting serious venture capital, as well as an FIS announcement to do it again in 2017.

I saw our traditional education system creatively address an important need by forming the North Little Rock Center of Excellence, where students can choose a curriculum path that prepares them for immediate success via direct entry to the workforce as an alternative to college.

I saw thousands of fans scream a loud "YES!" of community support for the Little Rock Trojans basketball team in the crucial home stretch of a magical 30-win season. This "Pack the Jack" effort that filled the arena for three late February home games was a great example of how people here will come together with gusto to support local success.

I was fascinated by the thoughtful debate surrounding our major infrastructure projects. State and city officials, planning agencies, business interests, and interested citizens have all worked together, often passionately with competing viewpoints, but always recognizing the importance of compromise. We now see the new Broadway Bridge taking shape, a product of such compromise. And 2016 was sometimes dominated by clashing views of how 30 Crossing should look and function. Nothing is finalized, but AHTD's current plan for the I-30 Bridge is vastly different than the original, all because our citizens cared enough to participate in a sometimes messy but productive planning process.

Our Technology Park found its first tenants. Our Port Authority has begun acquiring expansion land. We have a regional headquarters for Sprint, a new maintenance center for Envoy Air, and a recently announced facility that will manufacture athletic apparel. Our county school district has returned to local control with an elected board. All these things happen when cooperation surpasses conflict and "yes" is the default answer to questions and challenges.

Are we finished? Can we rest? Absolutely not. Our future will only be bright if we keep working together on significant challenges. We must find better ways to enhance public safety and reduce criminal activity, take the long view in creating sites with appropriate infrastructure to put our region on the short lists of the best employers, and keep supporting our schools and those special individuals who lead our districts and teach our children. After this year as your chairman, I am confident that our community will meet these challenges. I've seen how we cooperate while we debate, how we listen to those with whom we disagree, and how so many of us will step up without hesitation and go to work solving problems that impact our quality of life.

Thanks to you – the people of the Little Rock region – we had a great year, and we will have many more!


## THE TRANSFORMATION OF A REGION

When the Little Rock Regional Chamber began staffing the Metro Little Rock Alliance 11 years ago, economic development marketing efforts of our 12-county region were made one. Since then, this regional partnership has generated historic results from directly-worked expansion and new company locations to the region. The sum of these efforts has proven to be greater than its individual parts, just as our collective voice has travelled farther and delivered our region's story to a greater audience than we could have individually reached.

For over a decade, 100 chamber members have lead economic, talent, and community development by meeting 70% of the chamber's economic development funding needs with the remaining 30% coming from public sources. Through this partnership, the region has realized 15,037 new jobs, \$516,210,921 in new payroll, and over \$2 billion in new capital investment.

Our economic development work has created new infrastructure investment for the Little Rock Technology Park while also funding a significant expansion of the Little Rock Port. These investments, combined with improvements in transportation and pro-business advocacy efforts, have maximized the metro Little Rock region's attractiveness to established and emerging industries for unparalleled future opportunity.





## 2016 SUCCESS STORIES

### MAINSTREAM TECHNOLOGIES ANNOUNCES EXPANSION

On August 18, Mainstream Technologies announced plans to open a second location in downtown Conway. The new Conway location began operations in September and will initially have 15 employees. The company plans to hire an additional 30 high-wage technology employees over the next five years. Mainstream provides managed services, custom software, and hosting to clients throughout the mid-South.



### HILLCREST CAMSHAFT SERVICE EXPANDS IN LITTLE ROCK

Hillcrest Camshaft Service expanded its operations on West 65th Street with the construction of a new 18,000-square-foot building to accommodate a new crankshaft grinding facility. The facility will allow the company to remanufacture crankshafts for locomotive, marine, and heavy equipment uses. The project will create five new jobs and a \$1.8 million capital investment.

### LM WIND POWER EXPANDS AT LITTLE ROCK PORT

Wind turbine blade manufacturer LM Wind Power broke ground on a new warehouse facility at the Little Rock Port. The new 44,000-square-foot warehouse and pre-molding facility will transition employees from their Scott Hamilton location to the port location, allowing LM to store materials on site and reduce transportation costs and increase efficiencies.

### SPRINT ESTABLISHES REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS IN LITTLE ROCK

Sprint announced plans to open a regional office in Little Rock to serve as the South Central Headquarters which includes Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, and Oklahoma. As part of the expansion, Sprint plans to add approximately 100 new, full-time employees in Little Rock by the end of 2016. Sprint celebrated the grand opening of the new office at 900 South Shackleford in July.



### ENVOY AIR ESTABLISHES MAINTENANCE FACILITY AT CLINTON NATIONAL AIRPORT

Envoy Air Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of American Airlines Group, announced it will establish a new aircraft maintenance facility at the Bill and Hillary Clinton National Airport. The project will invest more than \$2 million and bring 60 new jobs to the area over the next five years. The new facility will provide maintenance support for the carrier's growing fleet of 76-seat Embraer 175 (E175) aircraft.

## G.C. EVANS SALES AND MANUFACTURING AND SLEEVE SEAL EXPAND LITTLE ROCK OPERATIONS

G.C. Evans Sales and Manufacturing and Sleeve Seal announced they are expanding their operations in Little Rock. The two companies will invest a combined \$6.4 million creating 43 new jobs and will move into the former Siemens facility on Dineen Drive. G.C. Evans manufactures packaging and process equipment for the food, bottling, and pharmaceutical industries. Sleeve Seal supplies high-speed labeling equipment and printed shrink labels.

## HIA VELO ESTABLISHES BICYCLE MANUFACTURING FACILITY IN LITTLE ROCK

The founder of Orbea USA, Tony Karklins, purchased Guru Cycles out of Canada at an auction after it filed for bankruptcy and decided to relocate it to the U.S. Under the new name, HIA Velo, LLC, the company has established a facility on Brookwood Drive in Little Rock and will be creating more than 50 new jobs. The company is developing new biking products and brands to manufacture and distribute globally.



## SUZHOU TIANYUAN GARMENTS COMPANY ESTABLISHES FACILITY IN LITTLE ROCK

Chinese apparel manufacturer Suzhou Tianyuan Garments Company announced that it will invest more than \$20 million and bring 400 jobs to the Little Rock area. Tianyuan specializes in the production of casual and sport apparel for Adidas, Reebok, and Armani.

## ZERO MOUNTAIN EXPANDS INTO NORTH LITTLE ROCK

Zero Mountain Inc. will be expanding from Fort Smith into North Little Rock and establishing a cold storage warehouse in an existing building on East Gregory Street. The project will create 15 new jobs and an investment of \$7.4 million in renovations and machinery.

## ATA INTERNATIONAL CELEBRATES GRAND OPENING

ATA International, Inc., formerly American Taekwondo Association, celebrated the grand opening of its new World Headquarters in November. The new campus-style headquarters is located in Riverdale and houses the Eternal Grand Master H.U. Lee Museum, corporate offices, and an International Training Center. The \$12 million project broke ground in June 2015.



## GROWING THE REGION'S WORKFORCE

### CHAMBER HOSTS CAREER TECH THINK TANK FOR LITTLE ROCK SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Little Rock Regional Chamber hosted a “think tank” session with Little Rock School District (LRSD) Superintendent Michael Poore. The session included business leaders from various industries as well as political leaders and education professionals, to brainstorm on the creation of “career centers” in the Little Rock School District and to identify which career strands are of the greatest priority to the community.



### NORTH LITTLE ROCK SCHOOL DISTRICT LAUNCHES MANUFACTURING COURSES

The North Little Rock School District began teaching two new courses in the Advanced Manufacturing career pathway in August. Two new teachers were hired to teach Introductory Craft Skills and Introduction to Manufacturing classes to the **195 ENROLLED STUDENTS**. Work is now underway in the Little Rock School District to develop similar career pathway centers.

### LITTLE ROCK REGIONAL CHAMBER, PULASKI TECHNICAL COLLEGE, CITY OF MAUMELLE HOST MFG DAY

In celebration of Manufacturing Day 2016, the Little Rock Regional Chamber, Pulaski Technical College (PTC), and the City of Maumelle hosted a manufacturing exhibition fair, presented by Entergy, on October 7 at the PTC-South Campus. Twenty-one exhibitors from within the region provided interactive exhibits to more than 1,000 local middle school and high school students as part of an effort to change student’s perceptions about today’s manufacturing environment and draw attention to the outstanding opportunities that a career in manufacturing can provide.

### NORTH LITTLE ROCK SCHOOL DISTRICT RECEIVES APPROVAL FOR CENTER OF EXCELLENCE

The Arkansas Department of Education’s charter authorization panel and the Arkansas Board of Education approved the North Little Rock School District’s (NLRSD) Center of Excellence charter school to be housed on the North Little Rock High School campus. The Center of Excellence will offer instruction in the career fields of computer science, advanced manufacturing, engineering, health care, and transportation, distribution and logistics. The Little Rock Regional Chamber has been actively involved with NLRSD in this process and spoke in support of the Center of Excellence at the hearing.

## CHAMBER ADVOCACY EFFORTS FOR 2016

### ISSUE 3

#### *Economic Development Amendment to the Arkansas Constitution*

Chamber leaders and staff worked to pass the Arkansas constitutional amendment known as Issue 3, which removes the cap on the amount of bond financing the legislature can apply towards Amendment 82 “super projects,” previously limited to 5% of general revenue. It also expressly permits municipalities to contract with economic development entities for services. **Arkansas voters overwhelmingly approved Issue 3 by a margin of 65% to 35%.**

### MEETINGS WITH ARKANSAS CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION

#### *Washington, D.C.*

Chamber leaders spent time in Washington meeting with both senators and all four congressmen about issues concerning the business community.



### SECOND CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT LUNCHEON

The chamber hosted a 2nd Congressional District Luncheon featuring Congressman French Hill as part of the Arkansas State Chamber’s Washington DC Fly-In.

### 30 CROSSING

The chamber brought together a broad cross-section of community stakeholders to collaborate with Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department officials and engineers on an alternative design for the redevelopment of the portion of Interstate 30 that passes through downtown Little Rock and North Little Rock known as “30 Crossing.” The resulting plan eliminates the 2nd Street exit system, including the cloverleaf exit ramps and the long, elevated on/off ramp running east-west between 2nd and 3rd streets, replacing it with 17 acres of permanent green space.

This exciting new design, endorsed by the chamber and various stakeholder groups, significantly benefits downtown Little Rock while also satisfying important safety and traffic movement objectives. It improves aesthetics by removing a major visual and pedestrian barrier, facilitates unencumbered east-west pedestrian access, and provides the opportunity to fully connect to the riverfront.

The **Arkansas Small and Minority Business Matchmaking Conference** was a collaboration between the AEDC, Arkansas Small Business and Technology Development Center, Arkansas Procurement Assistance Center, Windstream, SCORE, and the Arkansas District Office of the U.S. Small Business Administration. Over 300 small and minority business owners from across the state met face-to-face with over 80 representative from colleges, universities, federal, state, and local government agencies as well as

private corporations. Companies and individuals seized this unique opportunity to meet with buyers and suppliers that were motivated to award contracts and sub-contracts to smaller businesses.

The **Minority Business Awards Luncheon**, the capstone event for MED Week, featured keynote speaker Janis F. Kearney, author, publisher, lecturer, presidential historian, and literary/arts advocate. The Gould, Arkansas, native and acclaimed author closed out the 34th Annual MED Week with an inspiring talk that ranged from education and literacy to activism and community involvement. The lunch recognizes minority-owned businesses and business owners that excelled in their field as well as an organization dedicated to supporting minority-owned businesses.

Darrin Williams, CEO of Southern Bancorp, accepted their award for Supporting Organization of the Year. Southern Bancorp creates economic opportunity in rural and underserved communities by providing responsible and responsive financial products and services that balance profits with purpose.

The Little Rock Regional Minority Entrepreneur of the Year Award went to R.J. Martino of iProv. Martino founded iProv in 2001 by building custom apps and websites on a project-by-project basis. Fifteen years later, the company has grown into a full-service, managed IT and Internet marketing firm. They service approximately 60 clients in Arkansas and beyond, using flat-rate, monthly service packages that are custom-designed to meet individual needs.

Timmons Arts Foundation took home the Little Rock Regional Minority Business of the Year Award. Timmons Arts Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization that partners with school districts to provide musical instruments and art supplies to schools where art and music are absent or limited in their curriculum, and awards grants to selected arts and music programs throughout the state.

The Little Rock Minority Business Legacy Award honors an individual or business with a sustained record of business community achievement in our region. The 2016 awardee was Charles Stewart, Chief Executive Officer of Stewart Real Estate Development, LLC.

### VC FINTECH ACCELERATOR

In May, ten companies from around the world converged on Little Rock for the summer to join the inaugural portfolio of the VC FinTech Accelerator. The VC FinTech Accelerator – empowered by FIS and championed by the chamber at its 2015 Annual Meeting – is a rigorous, 12-week program designed to accelerate the growth of early-stage financial technology services startups.

The program culminated with a successful Global Investor Demo Day at the Clinton Presidential Center in August. At the event, Gary Norcross, the CEO of FIS, and Governor Asa Hutchinson announced an agreement to fund the program through 2018. Recruiting for the second cycle of this groundbreaking program is underway.



## POPUPI IN THE ROCK: POPUP METRO HUB

For the fifth annual PopUp in the Rock project, Create Little Rock and studioMAIN reimagined Rock Region Metro's Travel Center in downtown Little Rock. The goal of PopUp Metro Hub was to not only raise awareness of the area and its potential, but also to discover the needs of the bus ridership and envision ways to meet those needs. Demonstration aspects included bus rapid transit routes, a popup farmers market, new bus shelters, and a popup café.

PopUp in the Rock isn't a street fair or a block party. Rather, it's a temporary urban demonstration – a live rendering – of what is possible.



## THINK BIG LITTLE ROCK

In August 2016, Create Little Rock launched its most ambitious program yet: Think Big Little Rock. Funded by Fifty for the Future and facilitated by the University of Arkansas’s Institute for Economic Advancement, Think Big is a year-long visioning process bringing together young professionals ages 25-40 with the goal of improving Little Rock’s overall quality of place and making it a community in which young professionals will want to live and work.



A selection committee chose 55 individuals, including four co-chairmen, to serve as the Steering Committee. Young professionals from the community at large were encouraged to apply.

The Steering Committee began with a half-day work session on Sunday, September 11, where they selected six areas of study: Economic Development, Public Education, Public Safety & Governance, Transportation & Environment, Arts & Culture, and Diversity.

Task forces were formed for each of the study areas to define problems and develop imple-

mentable strategy proposals. All young professionals, not just those on the Steering Committee, were invited to join a task force, resulting in over 170 participants. The co-chairs also added a Messaging Committee to effectively communicate the progress of Think Big throughout the year.

Think Big meets for a three-hour session each month. Additionally, subcommittees have formed within the task forces that meet outside of the regular sessions. Participants will work during the first six months to identify issues within the designated category and use the remaining months to identify potential solutions. Ideas will be submitted for public input midway through the initiative and again prior to the plan’s final recommendations through a series of town hall meetings. At the halfway point, the steering committee will hold a second half-day session to review the progress and make course corrections where needed.

At the end of the 12-month study period, a white paper will be prepared that outlines the problems or challenges of each designated subject study area, potential solutions, and potential funding sources for those solutions. There will also be additional community presentations.
